7 Rounded woods; $\varnothing \sim 10$ cm; l ~ 110 cm
 20 Rounded woods; $\varnothing \sim 7$ cm; l ~ 20 cm
 5 Half rounded woods; $\varnothing \sim 7$ cm; l ~ 20 cm
 15 Tree slices; $\varnothing \sim 16$ cm; l ~ 10 cm
 7 Plank; l x b x h; $\sim 110 \times 12 \times 2,8$ cm
 10 Squared woods; l x b x h; $\sim 10 \times 10 \times 25$ cm
 5 Triangles; l x b x h; $\sim 15 \times 12 \times 12$ cm
 15 Squared woods; l x b x h; $\sim 6 \times 10 \times 20$ cm
 (material: Robinia, polished; quantity and dimensions may vary slightly)

The mobile playbox includes simple basic elements, such as those found in the Frobelschen wooden kit. The children can build movement structures with the individual elements and try them out for themselves. In doing so, they learn about simple physical properties and laws such as weight, lever, steadfastness and others. The experience gained is constantly being developed and tested. This is how holistic learning takes place between the head and the body. The material can be expanded at will. The mobile playbox serves as a storage place for the individual wooden parts and is used by the children as a hiding box. Walls and lid can be painted.
